#### **APPLICANT ELIGIBILITY:**

Therefore, Council 15734 has stipulated that the eligibility criteria for a qualified applicant are the following;

- 1. The applicant and his/her family must be registered members of St. John Fisher Church of Marlborough, CT.
- 2. The applicant must be a practicing Catholic and must have received the Sacrament of Confirmation.
- 3. Entrant must be a graduating senior in the Class of December 2023 or June 2024.
- 4. Entrant must be accepted at two- or four-year college, university or an accredited degree or certificate awarding institution of higher learning. The applicant must show evidence of his/her commitment to matriculate at the institution, before the scholarship can be awarded.

#### **APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:**

The applicant must submit via email on or before the deadline of May 31, 2024 all of the following;

- 1. Application Cover Sheet
- 2. Activity Sheet <u>signed by a church official (e.g. youth minister, sacristan, pastor) and a school official (e.g. counselor, assistant principal, student council director)</u>. Due to the pandemic, signatures are requested, if unable to obtain please explain.
- 3. Essay of 500 words 1-2 pages doubled spaced, addressing the topic identified on the following essay sheet.

Each scholarship shall be in the amount of \$750.00.
